VINEYARD

The vineyard sites include three high-quality Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot vineyards in St. Helena. The vineyards are farmed to maximize quality and give the wine a complex and layered palate and a nice representation of Napa Valley Cabernet.

TASTING NOTES

On the nose, an enchanting aromatic tapestry unfolds, revealing delicate violet and rose petal accents interwoven with subtle whispers of sandalwood. The palate greets you with a lavish wave of succulent red berries and a nuanced undercurrent of chocolate. This medium-bodied wine strikes a harmonious balance, delivering a core of red cherry fruit, gracefully accented by threads of Madagascar vanilla and a hint of roasted cacao. The finish is remarkably polished, extending with delightful persistence, ensuring it's a versatile partner for a range of cuisines or the ideal pour for a relaxed evening.
