VINEYARD

The Piazza Chardonnay that comes from our “Cinghiale” (Italian for wild boar) Vineyard which is named for the frequent inhabitants of the property and was purchased in 2004. Overlooking the Pacific Ocean, it consists of 359 acres at the top of King Ridge in the Sonoma Coast appellation and is planted with 43 acres of pinot noir, syrah, chardonnay, and sauvignon blanc. In an effort to highlight the award-winning terroir, it features a variety of pinot noir and chardonnay clones with lineages hailing from the top vineyards in Burgundy as well as select top-rated clones from its neighbors in California.

TASTING NOTES

In 2023 we were fortunate to have enough beautiful fruit to once again offer the Piazza Chardonnay. All of the fruit is sourced from our Cinghiale vineyard and this blend features a sampling of all the various Chardonnay blocks. The wine is rich and expressive, has a simply delicious mouthfeel, and is an excellent introduction to our Cinghiale Chardonnays.
